Are you interested in a volunteer position with adventure, travel, a positive team environment? Consider applying to be the AAC National Team Healthcare Provider.

Responsibilities will include:

- Advise the 2023-24 AAC National Team members about how to physically prepare their dog(s) in the months leading up to the 2024 IFCS World Agility Championship
- Travel with the Team on their journey to the World Championships to provide Canine treatment, as required
- Provide treatment, as required, at the non-official team practice before IFCS as well as the official IFCS team practice.
- Assist the NTMC with fundraising campaigns to raise money for Healthcare costs.

More information:

- Fees associated with IFCS WAC 2024, i.e. airline, hotel, rental car (shared) and a team uniform will all be paid by the NTMC.
- There will also be a honorarium per dog, provided by the NTMC.
- This is a non-voting position on the NTMC and it is a one year term.
- The Healthcare Provider will be directly responsible to the NTMC.

Requirements:

- Must have experience in treating canine athletes.
- Must be an AAC member in good standing and 18 years of age or older.
- Must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- Cannot be a member of the 2024 AAC National Team.
- Agree to comply with the AAC Rules and Regulations and adhere to the AAC Code of Conduct.
- Agree to maintain confidentiality on NTMC deliberations

Previous experience treating dogs at an International Agility competition and veterinarians, as well as practitioners who can meet the needs of both human and canine athletes will be given priority. Great communication and people skills, a flexible schedule and bilingualism will also be considered assets.
